1. 38.9 Once score has been set in the timed events, it will not be changed at that rodeo, nor can length of box be changed.

AMEND TO:

38.9 Once the score, barrier or automatic barrier has been set in timed events, it will not be changed at the rodeo nor can the length of box or electric eye be changed. If any of this does occur, all competitors will be offered a re-run or if in the opinion of the barrier judge the contestant obviously did not break the barrier, no penalty will be imposed.

3. New Rule to be Added:

If a competitor fails to respond as ready to compete once the chute boss has called their name three (3) times the chute boss can then call on the next competitor in the draw. Once that next barrel racer fills that position, there will be no opportunity for the competitor that failed to respond to compete. A safe and clear entry area must be provided for all competitors.

The electric timer shall be set at the same height and position for each performance or slack. The height of the timers shall be between 36 inches (91.4cm) and 42 inches (106.7cm) from the ground.

38.22 Within the confines of the timed event box it is the privilege of a contestant to dismiss someone from the box or have up to three (3) persons in the box for assistance. He may instruct the judge to either remove or allow other people in the box. No horse is to be in the side of the rope box during a one person event. (Rope and Tie and Breakaway Roping.)

8. New Rule to be Added:

All judges are to be put on a three (3) strike penalty system. The system will work as follows: If an issue or complaint in writing is brought to the board by a member an investigation will be opened by the board. If the judge or judges are found to be at fault they shall be sent a letter stating what the issue is about and what appropriate measures should have taken place at the time. This will result in one strike being placed against the judge's name.

If the same judge makes another mistake after being sent a letter on the previous issue and is notified of the strike against their name. They will then be issues with a second strike. This will result in the judge at fault being stood down until they can attend a Judge's Clinic hosted by the APRA. Once they attend this clinic they can then keep judging with two strikes against their name.

If a third incident occurs they will receive a third strike and be stood down. They may reapply to be an affiliated judge but they will have to do another clinic and shadow judge an appropriate amount of rodeos until the board sees them fit to judge another rodeo.

If there is tow or more years in between incidents the strikes shall be removed and they will have a clean record.

Any head of stock that turns around in the chute when leaving classes as a foul and qualifies for a re-ride option. Contestant that goes on with it will still receive a option.

38.2 Barrier to be no less than 6' for the Steer Wrestling and Team Roping events with a minimum length 10' for Steer Roping, Rope and Tie and Breakaway Roping events. If the length of the arena or stock does not accommodate a 10' barrier – the barrier judge, stock

An open arena shall be defined as an arena with minimum dimensions as follows: - 75 metres in length, 35 metres in width with a time event box with a minimum depth of 4.575 metres (15 feet).

22. 1.8 The cut off date for each membership year will be the 30th August each year and membership will be due on the 1st of September of that same year the cut off date for each year will be due 30th of April each year and membership will be due on the 1st May of the same year.

1.8 The cut off date for each membership year will be the 30th September each year and membership will be due on the 1st of October of that same year. The cut off date for each junior membership will be due 30th of April each year and membership will be due on the 1st May of the same year

23. 27.15 50% of the top 12 that are entered at a rodeo from the previous seasons standings are to draw in the performance and the other 50% are to be drawn at random. E.g. If 6 of the top 12 are entered in a rodeo 50% are to be drawn in the performance and the other 50% are to be drawn at random.

AMEND TO:

27.15 The top 15 competitors from the previous season should not draw up in the slack UNLESS they preference for the slack. Day members are not to be drawn in the performance unless requested by committee or promoter running the rodeo. Five (5) preferences will be given to all members whether it be slack or performance in one membership year. Contestants must NOT be present on the rodeo grounds whilst slack is on if preference for the performance was granted by the APRA office. Contestant will be disqualified from competing if on the grounds.

24. 38.1 Timed event box to be at least twelve (12) feet in length.

26. 33.24 Timed event contractors are only permitted to use an electric prodder with a maximum of 5000 volts and no longer than 20cm in length. A prodder can only be utilized by the approved contractor/sub-contractor at each rodeo who will be held responsible for any misuse. This relates to all handling of timed event stock at a rodeo. Government regulations in each state must also be complied with. A first offence breach of this rule carries a fine of

\$500 to the approved stock contractor. A second offence breach will be referred to the Board of Directors.

AMEND TO:

33.24 Timed event contractors are only permitted to use an electric prodder with a maximum of 6900 volts and no longer than 33cm in length. A prodder can only be utilized by the approved contractor/sub-contractor (or worker approved by the contractor and contractors' responsibility) at each rodeo who will be held responsible for any misuse. This relates in each state and must also be complied with. A first offence breach of this rule carries a fine of \$500 to the approved stock contractor. A second breach will be referred to the Board of Directors.

27. 41.8 Steer Wrestling stock must weigh in the vicinity of 400lbs to 500lbs (181kg – 227kg) and be as even as possible stock to have suitable horns and must be nine (9) inches in length. Steers only to be used.

41.8 Steer Wrestling stock must weight in the vicinity of 400lbs to 500lbs (181kg – 227kg) and be as even as possible stock to have suitable horns and must be a minimum of nine (9) inches in length. Male cattle only to be used which includes steers and mickeys.

28. Rule to be Added:

Mandatory circuit levy of \$2.00 to be applied to every entry fee of every affiliated event ran under the APRA affiliation. This levy is to be collected by the APRA at the time of APRA levy's being paid to the APRA. This levy is then divided up to the circuits by which circuit the event was held in. In the instances of that event being ran in a state that does not have a current circuit the levy would be kept by the APRA.
